Inc. 5000 honors five Farmington Hills companies

Five Farmington Hills companies have been included in Inc. 5000's annual list of the fastest-growing private companies in America.

Companies included have demonstrated a consistent high level growth, something that is especially notable due to the difficult economic environment of recent years.

Serving industries such as automotive, education, technology and manufacturing, *Kyyba, Inc.* has been on the list every year since 2008. According to the Inc. 500 website, the company had a 3-year growth rate of 62 percent and 2014 revenues above \$32 million.

"Our entire team is honored to once again be included in the Inc. 5000 list," *Kyyba* President and CEO Tel Ganesan said in a press release. "Being named amongst the top private companies in the country is extremely humbling and fills us all with a great sense of pride."

Five-time honoree *Mango Languages*, which develops language-learning resources, reported a 65 percent 3-year growth rate and \$9.8 million in 2014 revenues. The company has added 20 jobs.

LinTech Global provides IT and engineering services to federal and commercial clients across the U.S. The company made the list with a 462 percent 3-year growth rate, \$10.1 million in 2014 revenue, and the addition of 69 jobs.

IT consulting firm *Saturn Tech*, which offers "management consulting, business analysis and project outsourcing," added 70 jobs in 2014, with \$4.7 million in revenues. The company has a 176% 3-year growth rate.

Duffey Petrosky, another 5-time honoree, specializes in advertising campaigns for print and broadcast media. The company reported \$15.8 million in revenues and added 18 employees in 2014. Its 3-year growth rate is 78 percent.

Honorees will be celebrated at the 2015 Inc. 5000 Conference and Gala, Oct. 21-23, in Orlando, Florida.
